ASAD Uniform Policy

August 2023

Objective

The uniform is a vital element of ASAD School's identity. It serves multiple purposes:

- Enhances the learning environment.
- Fosters unity among students.
- Encourages student pride.
- Eliminates socio-economic barriers by treating all students equally.

Scope

This policy applies to all students enrolled at ASAD School, from kindergarten through grade 12.

Uniform Components

Boys

- School blazer
- School shirt
- School trousers and belt
- Black leather shoes
- School tie
- School jumper (in winter months)

Girls

- School blazer
- School shirt
- School skirt or trousers and belt
- Black leather shoes
- School jumper (in winter months)

PE (Physical Education) Uniform

- School PE shirt
- School PE shorts or pants
- Sports shoes

Guidelines for Compliance

1. **Daily Checks:** Uniform compliance will be checked daily during the morning assembly.
2. **Consequences:** Non-compliance will result in a written notice that must be signed by the parents and returned to the school.

3. **Uniform Care:** All items should be clean and in good condition. The shirt must always be tucked in.
4. **Footwear:** Only black leather shoes are permitted. Sports shoes are only allowed during PE classes.

Breach of Uniform Policy

If a student is found to be in breach of the Uniform Policy, the following checklist will be used to communicate the infraction to parents:
